Reading and Writing support plan for Grades K-6

RTI (Response to Intervention) or SRBI (Scientifically Research Based Intervention

<u>Tier 1</u> - Classroom instruction (all students)

<u>Tier 2</u> - Small group instruction- by para-educators and classroom teachers

<u>Tier 3</u>- 1:1 or small group instruction provided by Reading Consultants or Special Educators

Tier 1: Readers and Writers Workshop Model Focus

- Monthly literacy team meeting with an instructional focus based on data
- ➤ Monthly Literacy Bulletin highlighting key dates, literacy strategies and instructional expectations
- ➤ Staff Book Club- K-3 staff are all reading <u>Comprehension</u> <u>From the Ground Up</u> by Sharon Taberski which has a Readers' and Writers' Workshop Model Focus. Staff grades 4-6 are all reading <u>Around the Readers Workshop</u> <u>in 180 Days</u> by Frank Serafini
- ➤ Provide on-going support at staff meeting in an effort to include literacy across the content areas
- ➤ Responded to administrative walkthrough feedback by providing resources for expanding classroom libraries
- Whole school literacy initiatives to foster a school wide culture of literacy such as Graffiti Wall, Theme wall, Nutmeg Challenge, Genre focus, Word of the Day
- ➤ Coaches' Data Wall to track support provided for Readers' and Writers' workshop
- ➤ Initiated a K-6 DRA2 data collection and analysis process
- ➤ Modeling, planning and team teaching opportunities provided to support all teachers in improving instruction

- ➤ Monthly Region #4 Reading Consultant meetings to plan and coordinate assessments, improve coaching support and collaborate
- ➤ Organize multiple out-of-district professional development opportunities to directly align with instructional needs of teachers (Connecticut Reading Conference, ELL workshops, etc.)
- ➤ Collaborating with Deep River Library Board and DRES librarian to extend our community of readers and the culture of literacy at DRES
- ➤ Support incoming Kindergarten parents and students through a daily activity calendar and provide literacy resource materials
- Summer Reading book lists for each grade level and kickoff picnic

Tier 2

- Classroom teachers, Reading consultants and administrators make decisions for grouping and movement of students through the Tiers monthly at SRBI meetings.
- > Students who make grade level progress are discontinued from Tier 2.
- ➤ Tier 2 interventionists are monitored by the Reading Consultants through weekly meetings and monthly observations and through the SRBI process.

Kindergarten

 Direct support in classrooms by reading consultant and para-educators (1:1 and in small groups) using Letter ID/Letter Sound, Sight Word, Word Analysis and Phonemic Awareness assessment data

Grades 1 and 2

- Using Fountas and Pinnell Leveled Literacy Intervention (LLI) to provide read 3 students at a time in a small group setting
- Grouping decisions are all based on DRA2, Letter ID/Sound, Sight Word, Phonemic Awareness and other assessment data

Grades 3-6

- Small group instruction with para-educators using Mondo intervention kit, Nancy Boyles' resources for RTI and other comprehension and fluency resources
- Grouping determined using CMT, DRA2 and other ongoing current assessment data. 1:1 support provided by Reading Consultant in Tier 3.

Tier 3

- 1:1 support provided by Reading Consultants
- After at least 6 weeks of Tier 3 intervention, decisions are made regarding Special Education intervention or reentry into Tier 2 for continues support.
